



Blue Skies Table Topper

Approximately 40" square

Fabric Requirements

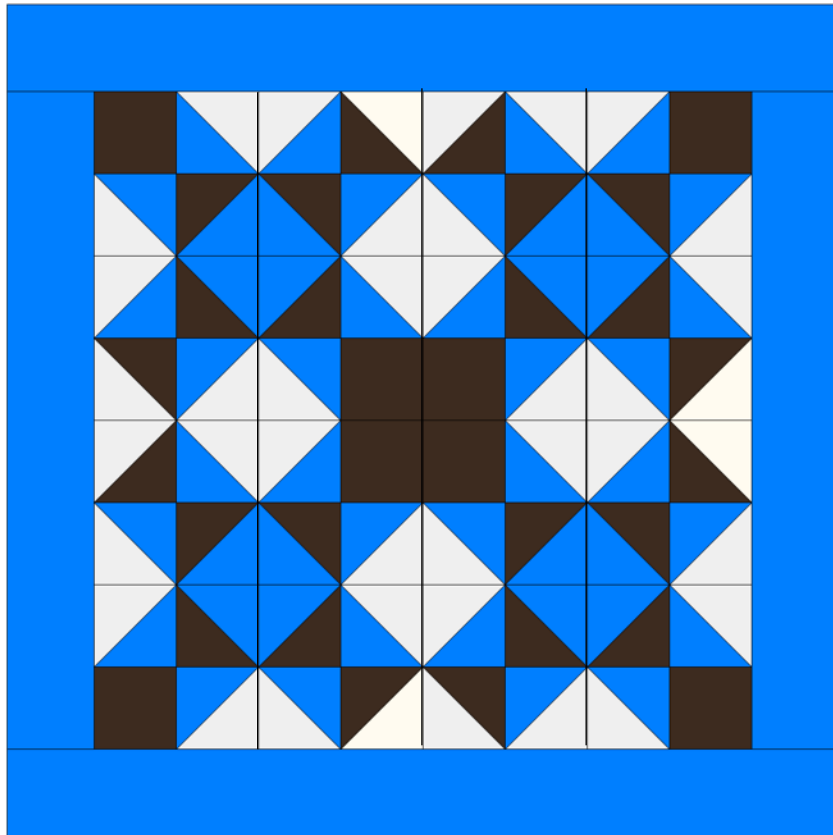
Fabric	Yardage	Piece Size
Dark	1/2 yard	8 - 4 1/2" squares 24 - 4 1/2" Half Square Triangles
Medium	2 1/3 yard	48 - 4 1/2" Half Square Triangles 5 - 4 1/2" Width of Fabric strips 44" square for backing
Light	1/2 yard	40 - 4 1/2" Half Square Triangles
Coordinate	1/4 yard	4 - 2" Width of Fabric strips for Double Fold Binding cut on crosswise grain

NOTE: Seam allowances are 1/4 inch unless otherwise stated.

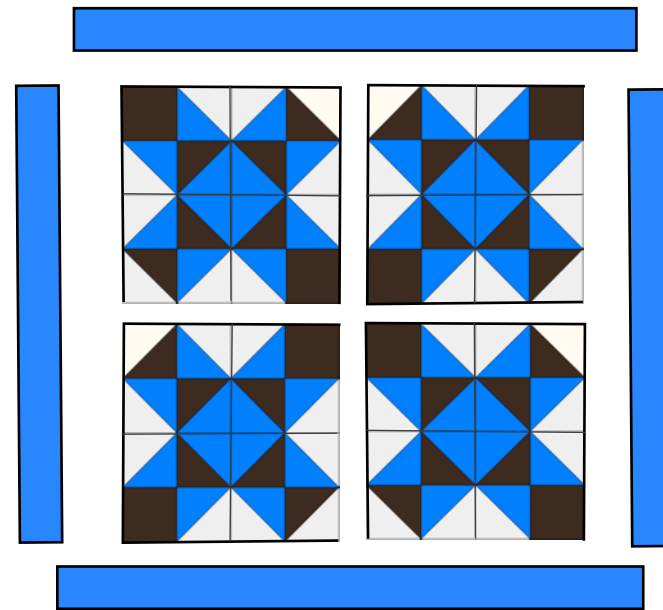

Pieces cut using Big Shot by Sizzix.

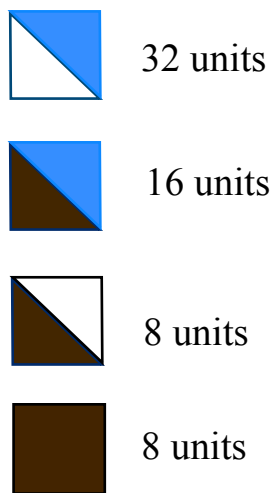




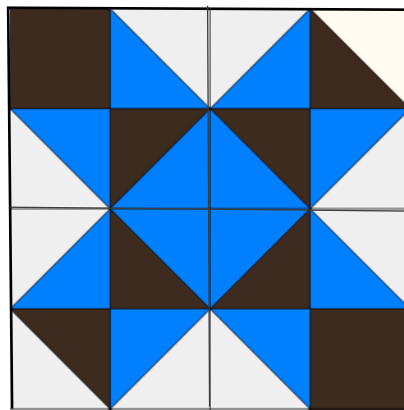
Blue Skies Table Topper



Topper Layout



Block Arrangement



4 units

Sew half square triangles together to make the required units. (See chart at left.)

Join units together to make block using the block arrangement guide.

Using the topper layout guide, join together all four blocks. Cut two strips the width of the pieced blocks. Sew one to left edge and one to right edge. Cut two strips the width of the pieced top. Sew one to top edge and one to bottom edge.

Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Baste. Quilt as desired.

Sew binding strips together. Fold in half lengthwise. Press. Bind edges of quilt.
