

Out the Door ID Keeper

Sometimes you just need to run out for a quick errand. Maybe it's a trip to the grocery store for chocolate. Or to go to the library for your next read. Even to grab a cup of coffee in the relative quiet of the corner cafe.

You don't need to take a big purse or tote. You really only need the essentials. And not every outfit has cargo pockets. So what to do? Grab your ID, debit card, or a few bills and head out. The Out the Door ID Keeper will attach to your key ring or fit in a pocket.

The Keeper is quick and easy to make. But even better, it's easy to personalize. Make one for every mood or whim.

Materials

3 - Five inch squares of cotton fabric

1 - Five inch square of thin batting (such as cotton batting)

1 - 4 ½ inch x 2 inch piece of Peltex or fusible fleece


Velcro hook and loop tape (sew on)

Ribbon

Decorative elements

Out the Door ID Keeper – Instructions


Iron Peltex or fusible fleece to wrong side of lower half of one square following manufacturer's instructions. Fold top half over and press.




Sew loop (fuzzy) side of velcro approximately 1/8 inch from folded edge.




Layer pieces in the following order starting on the bottom: batting, square selected for interior (right side up), pocket (velcro side up), square selected for exterior (wrong side up). Pin carefully, being careful not to shift the layers.



Sew through all layers using 1/4 inch seam allowance and a small stitch length. Leave an opening at the top approximately 2 3/4 inches to 3 inches wide. Clip corners.



Turn inside out. Press. Slipstitch opening closed. Edgestitch around square sewing through all layers. Sew hook side of velcro to the top of the interior approximately 1/4 inch from top edge being sure to align this piece with the piece on the pocket. Attach a loop of ribbon at the edge of keeper just above the upper edge of the pocket.



Decorate with buttons, yo-yo's or ribbon. Slide the side loop onto your key ring, and you're ready to go! Enjoy!
