

Positively Perfect Pincushion

A free pattern from 100 Billion Stars.

REQUIRED MATERIALS:

Quilting Cotton

- 1 - 4 1/2" square
- 2 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
- 1 - 8" x 4 1/2" rectangle
- 1 - small heart shaped piece for applique

Fusible Fleece - 8" x 4 1/2" rectangle

Fiberfil stuffing

Rick Rack - 2 - 4 1/2" pieces

Organza ribbon

Decorative button

Sewing thread

INSTRUCTIONS:

Right sides together, sew a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle to each side of the 4 1/2" square.

Following manufacturer's instructions, apply fusible fleece to wrong side of pieced front.

Sew rick rack along both seams.

Apply small heart shaped applique to lower right corner of back piece (8" x 4 1/2" piece) using a narrow zig zag. Leave at least 1/2" from edges to avoid catching it in the seam.

With right sides together, sew back to front leaving a gap of approximately 2 1/2" in one side for turning.

Clip corners. Turn inside out. Press.

Stuff well. Whipstitch opening with matching thread.

Tie ribbon into bow. Stitch to cushion front. Stitch decorative button on top of bow.

And you're done! Just like that!



NOTE: Seam allowances are 1/4".
