

It's A Snap!

Cuff Bracelet

Width = wrist _____ + 2" (6.35 cm)

Height = 1 1/2" (3.81 cm) to 2 1/2" (6.4 cm)

Cut two pieces.

Right sides together and using a 1/4" (.64 cm) seam allowance, sew pieces around all sides leaving a 3" (7.62 cm) gap for turning.

Clip corners. Turn inside out and press. Slipstitch opening closed.

Edgestitch approximately 1/8" (.3175 cm) from edge around all sides. Attach snaps 1/4" (.64 cm) from each edge following diagram.

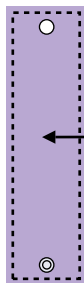
Add decorative elements as desired.

NOTE: For extra firmness, use interfacing on one or both pieces. Add a scant 1/4" (.64 cm) to the width of fabric pieces to allow for increased thickness.
