1 – 4 1/2" center square – Color A



4 – 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles – White



4 – 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles – Color B



4 – 2 1/2" squares – Color A

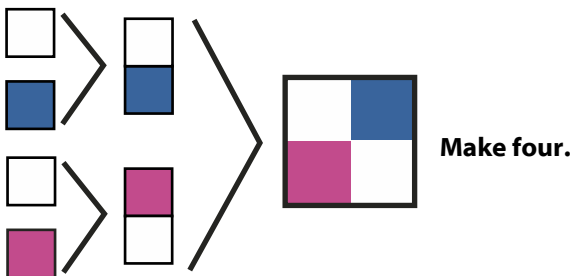


4 – 2 1/2" squares – Color B

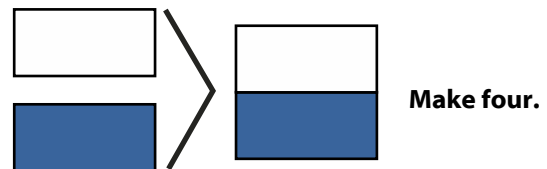


8 – 2 1/2" squares – White

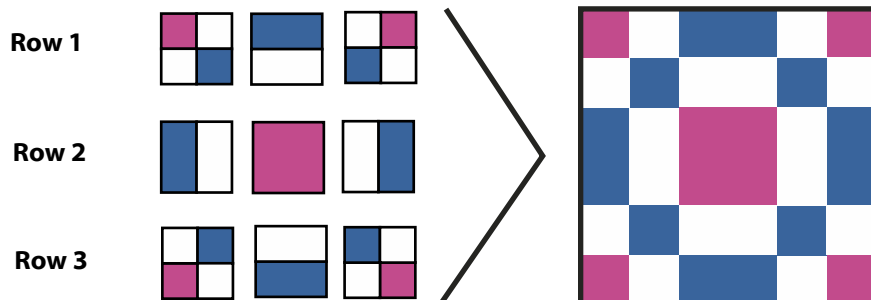
Four Patch

Design Notes:

When setting blocks for a quilt, use a bold dramatic print for the cornerstones and white for the sashing. Pick a print unlike any of those used in the blocks. For example, an animal print or fun polka dot will add unexpected points of interest.

Fussy cut the center squares.

Use up your scraps. Separate by color families to give order to your block. Or mix and match on a whim to create an eclectic look.

Substitute a tonal fabric instead of white.
