

Easy Geometry Table Topper

17 1/2" x 26 1/2"

Fabric requirements:

5 Fat Quarters **or** 1/4 yd. of five different prints

1/2 yd. White solid (front background)

1/2 yd. Coordinating print (backing)

1/4 yd. Print (binding cut on crosswise grain and squares)

Other supplies:

Batting (at least 18" x 27"), thread, pearl cotton size 8 for hand quilting, size 22 embroidery needle for pearl cotton, paper pieces (15 - 2" octagons and 8 - 2" squares).



English Paper Pieces



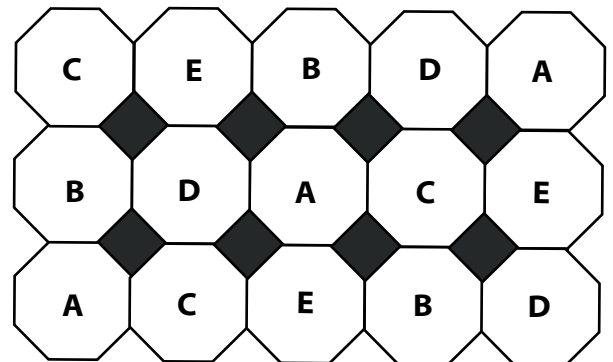
15 - 2" EPP Octagons

3 each of 5 different prints



8 - 2" EPP Squares

Layout



Cut 17 1/2" x 26 1/2" piece from white solid and from backing.

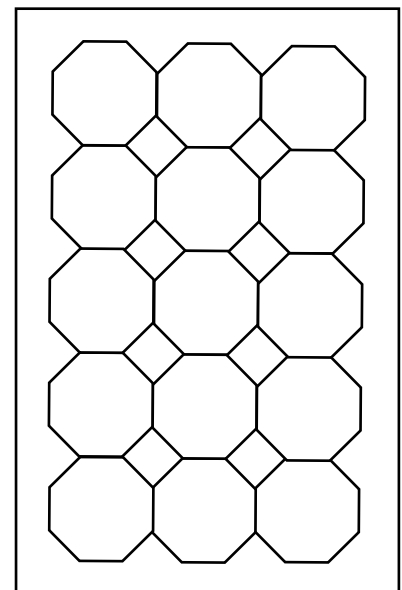
Assemble EPP pieces following diagram. Press well. Remove papers. Center piecing over the right side of white solid. Pin in place around all edges. (Alternatively, use a glue pen to secure all edges.) Edgestitch around all outside edges.

Cut batting and backing at least 18" x 27". Make a quilt sandwich of the backing, batting and top. Baste.

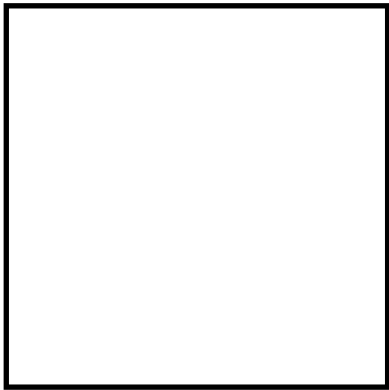
Using big stitches with the pearl cotton thread, hand quilt around the interior of each piece about 1/4" to 3/8" from edges of piece.

For binding, cut three 2" x WOF strips. Join end to end. Fold in half and press to make binding. Add binding to outside edges of piece using your preferred method.

Place on table and enjoy!

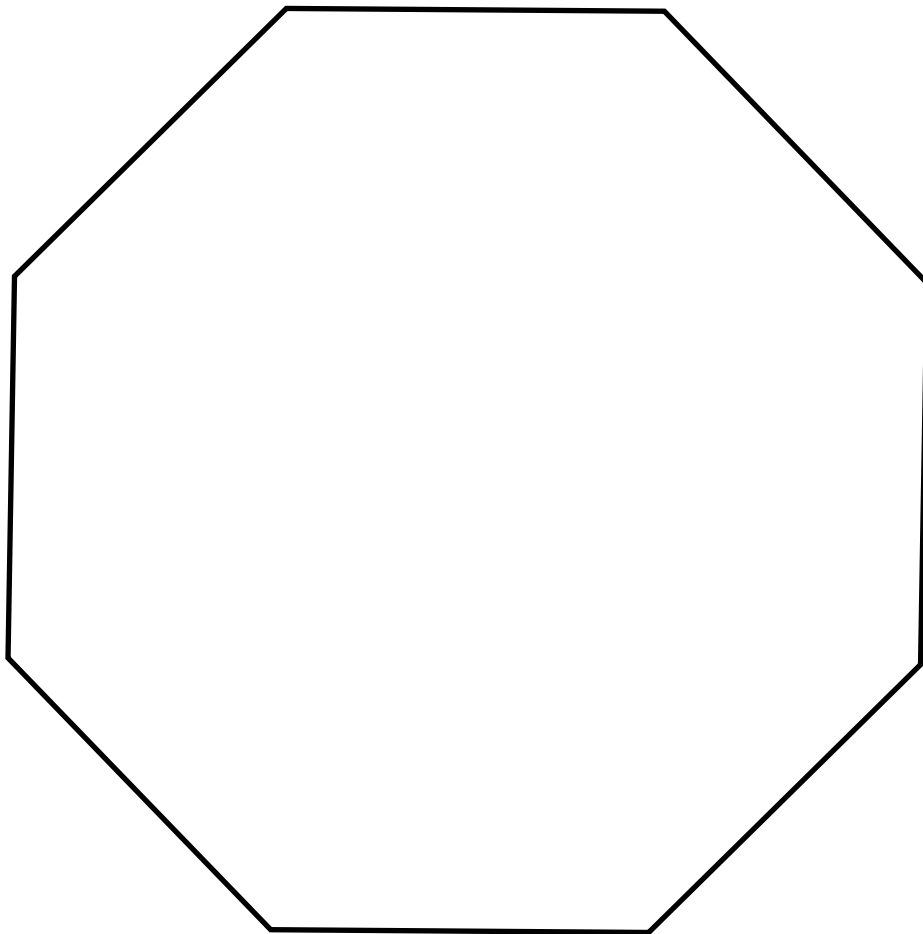


Easy Geometry Table Topper Pieces
