- 20" square, unfinished

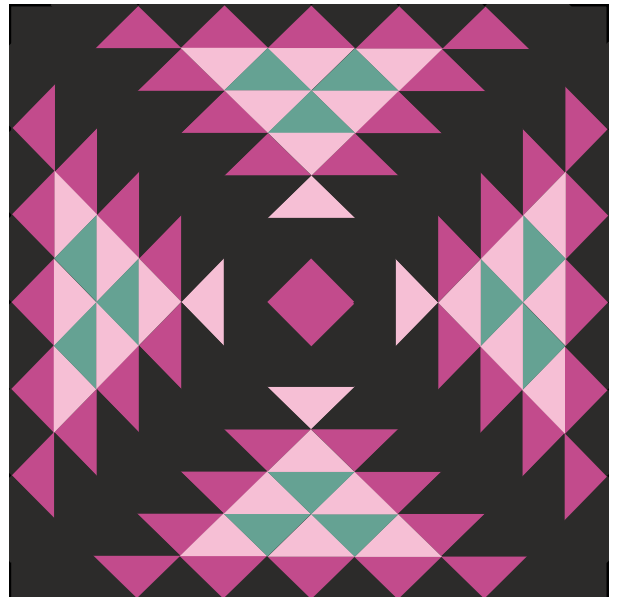
Yardage Requirements for one block:

Solid: 1/2 yard

Print 1: 1/4 yard

Print 2: 1/8 yard

Print 3: 1/8 yard



Cutting Instructions:



Solid:

24 - 2 1/2" squares

4 - 2 1/2" x 15" strips

4 - 5 3/4" squares

1 - 4 1/4" square



Print 1:

1 - 2 1/2" fussy cut square

4 - 5 3/4" squares

4 - 4 1/4" squares



Print 2:

7 - 4 1/4" squares



Print 3:

3 - 4 1/4" squares

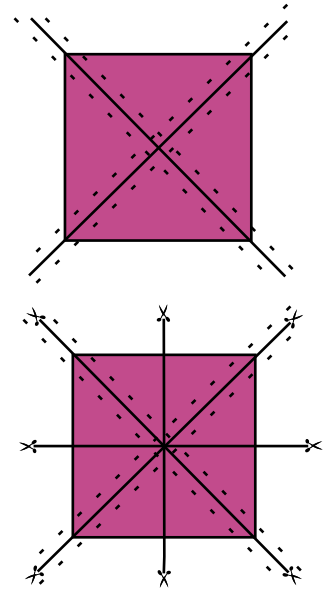
Instructions for 5 3/4" squares:

Place the appropriate two squares right sides together. Mark 1/4" from diagonal on each side. (These are the dotted lines in the diagram.)

Sew on marked lines (dotted lines).

Cut square in half vertically and horizontally. Cut both diagonal lines (solid lines).

Yields 8 HST pieces.

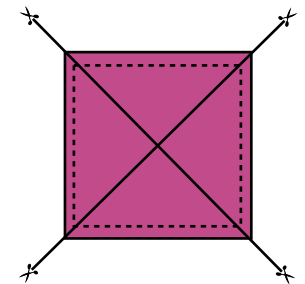


Instructions for 4 1/4" squares:

Place the appropriate two squares right sides together. Sew around the entire square using a precise 1/4" seam allowance.

Cut square along both diagonal lines.

Yields 4 HST pieces. Treat these carefully as the edges are on the bias. Use starch alternative to fix for ease of handling.

Made from 4 1/4" squares



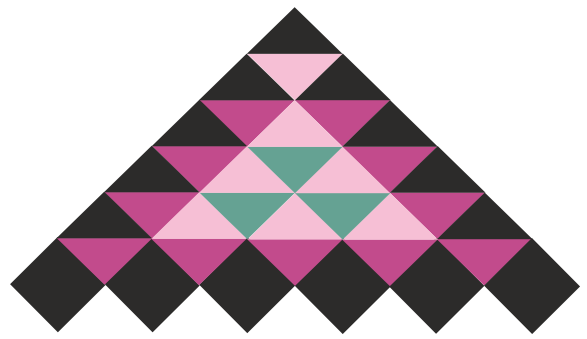
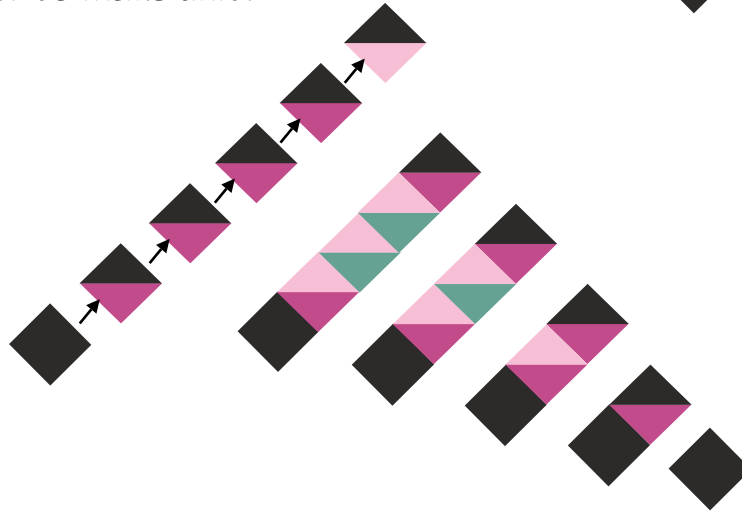

Make 4

Sew half square triangles together in rows as shown in diagram.

Sew rows together to make unit.



Block Assembly

Sew units to strips as shown.

Trim to 20" square.
