

Handy Helper Project Bag

Small 9"wide x 6" high x 3" deep

Materials	Yardage	Cut Sizes	Pieces
Print 1	¼ yard	2 - 12 1/2" x 8"	Front & Back Exterior
		1 - 15 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Strap Underside
Print 2	¼ yard	2 - 12 1/2" x 8"	Front & Back Interior
		1 - 15 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Strap Outside
Fusible Fleece	¼ yard	2 - 12 1/2" x 8"	Front & Back
		1 - 15 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Strap

Medium 9"wide x 9" high x 3" deep

Materials	Yardage	Cut Sizes	Pieces
Print 1	1/3 yard	2 - 12 1/2" x 11"	Front & Back Exterior
		1 - 15 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Strap Underside
Print 2	1/3 yard	2 - 12 1/2" x 11"	Front & Back Interior
		1 - 15 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Strap Outside
Fusible Fleece	1/3 yard	2 - 12 1/2" x 11"	Front & Back
		1 - 15 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Strap



Carry this little project bag over your arm and knit, crochet or sew on the go.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Note: Seam allowances are 1/4". WS means Wrong Side.

Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse fleece to wrong side of Front and Back Exterior and Strap Outside pieces.

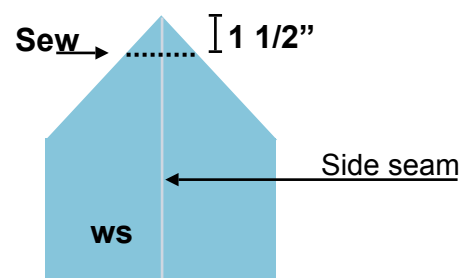
Right sides together, sew strap pieces along both long edges. Turn inside out and press.

Edgestitch along both seams.

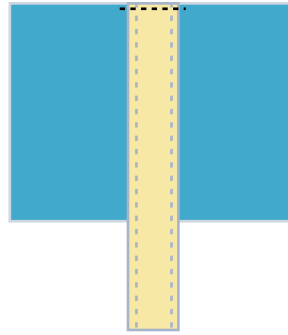
Right sides together, sew Front and Back Exterior pieces together down sides and across bottom edge. Clip corners.

Create 3 inch boxed ends in each side by aligning side and bottom seam and marking a line across the corner 1 1/2" from point on the wrong side.

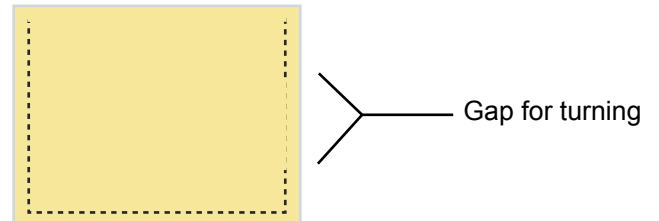
Stitch on line. Cut off corner leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.



Mark the center of front, back and both ends of the strap. Right sides together, center one end of the strap over center front and the other over center back. Stitch in place using a scant 1/4" seam allowance.



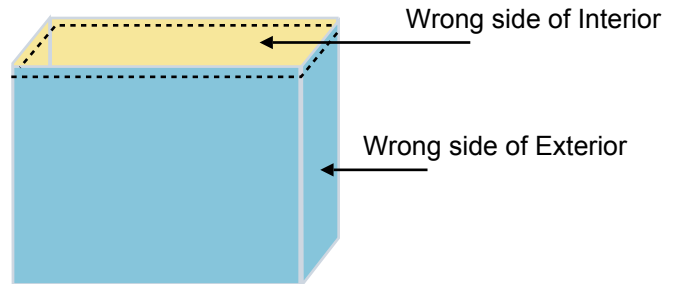
Right sides together, sew interior front and back pieces together leaving a 4" gap in one side for turning.



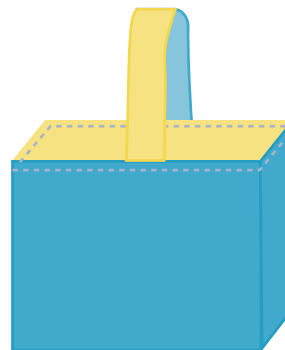
Box ends in the same manner as instructed for exterior.

With right sides together, pin top edges of exterior and interior. Sew.

Turn inside out and press. Slipstitch side opening of interior closed.



Edgestitch along top edge of bag.



And that's it! You're ready to load your bag with materials for your current project.

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
